- "Tiger Dance (Toramai)" is the folkloric entertainment of Kamaishi.
- "Daikannon" is 48.5 meters tall statue of the Buddhist goddess of mercy.
- "Steam Locomotive" Historically, the railway line of Kamaishi city was the third to be opened in Japan. "SL GINGA" currently operates.
- "Landscape of Chimneys" Kamaishi Steelworks was the first steelworks factory in Japan. It looks like a "steampunk" town.
- "The Gentleman with the Flag" He is "The Father of the Modern Steel Industry of Japan". His statue stands in front of Kamaishi station.
- "Rugby Stadium" Kamaishi is a City of Rugby.
 International rugby competition was held here
- "Yakushi Park" During WWII, Kamaishi was bombed many times because of the ironworks factories. Inside the park is a statue dedicated to peace.
